

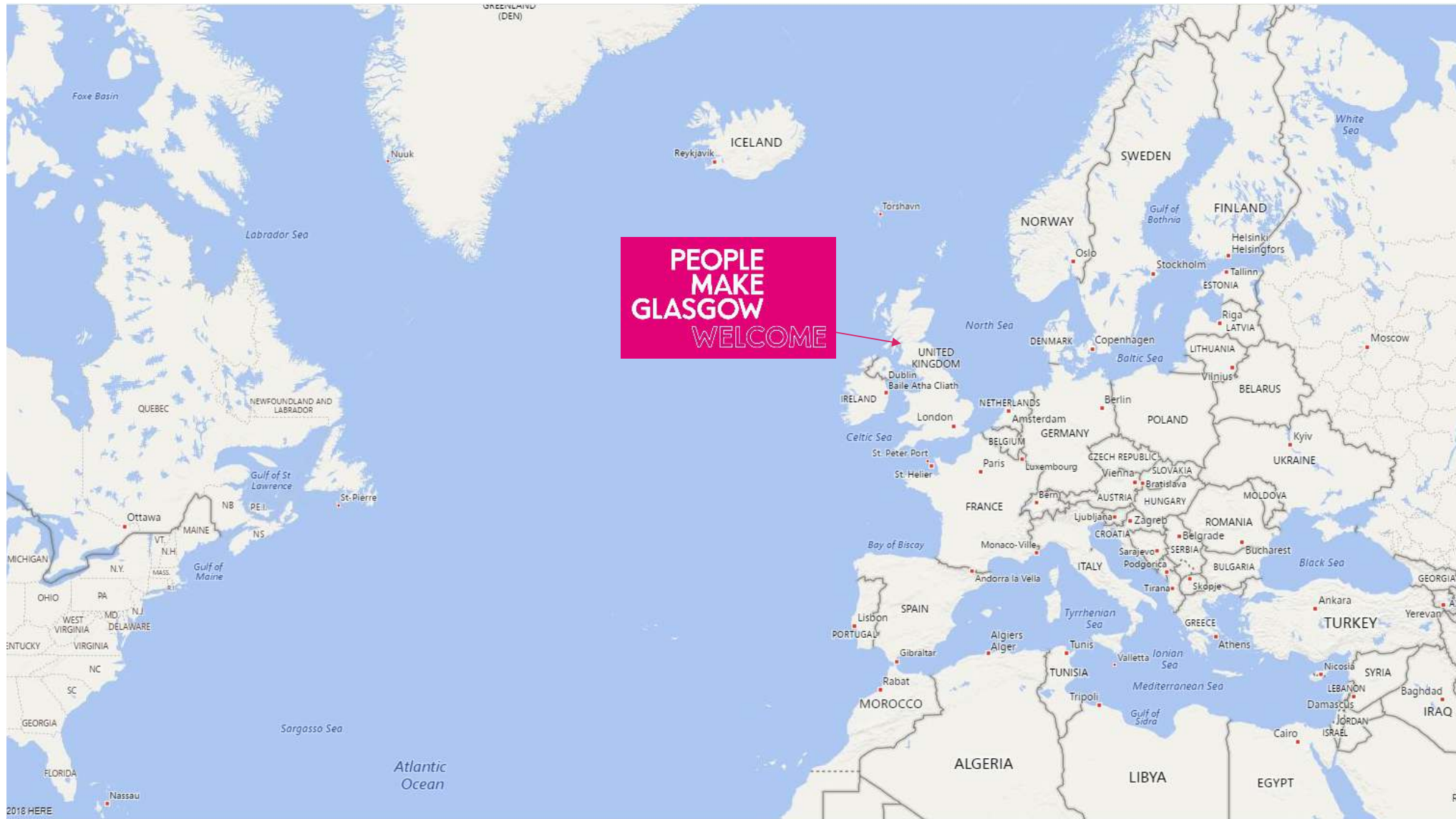

- 3 International Airports
